The belief still exists with great force in the majority of uneducated persons that the moon has great influence over the weather. The changes of the moon, full, new and half-moon, occur four times in every month and it is supposed that any change may influence the weather at least on the day preceding or following that of its occurrence. There will thus be twelve days out of every twenty eight on which any change of weather would be attributed to the moon, so that during the year many changes will thus be recorded as favourable to the opinion.

The uneducated observer is struck with these instances and remember them carefully, but he fails to observe, or at least to remember, that changes of weather often occur also when there is no change of the moon at all. The question could only be decided by a long course of careful and unbiased observation in which all facts favourable or unfavourable shall be equally recorded. All observations which have been published negate the idea that there can be any such influence as the vulgar mind attributes to the moon.
